

Scripture support for speech part 2 of introductory speech, the most effective words Satan has used to keep this world from knowing God:

Use find to locate the number you are looking for:

1. Matthew 11 – 23, v16. But blessed are your eyes, for they see: and your ears, for they hear. Luke 10: 1 – 24, v23. And he turned him unto his disciples, and said privately, Blessed are the eyes which see the things that ye see. Study also 1: Corinthians 2: 1 - 16. This portion tells us who can see and who cannot see and why.
2. Matthew 9: 18 – 33, v32. As they went out, behold, they brought to him a dumb man possessed with a devil. 33. And when the devil was cast out, the dumb spoke: and the multitudes marveled, saying, It was never so seen in Israel.
3. Hebrews 13: 2. Be not forgetful to entertain strangers: for thereby some have entertained angels unawares.
4. Matthew 16: 15 – 23, v23. But he turned, and said unto Peter, Get thee behind me, Satan: thou art an offence unto me: for you savor not the things that be of God, but those that be of men.
5. 1 Kings 3: 7 – 12, v8. And your servant is in the midst of your people which you have chosen, a great people, that cannot be numbered nor counted for multitude. 9. Give therefore your servant an understanding heart to judge your people, that I may discern between good and bad: for who is able to judge this your so great a people? Hebrews 5: 12. For when for the time you ought to be teachers, you have need that one teach you again which be the first principles of the oracles of God; and are become such as have need of milk, and not of strong meat. 13. For every one that uses milk is un-skilful in the word of righteousness: for he is a babe. 14. But strong meat belongs to them that are of full age, even those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil.
6. Hebrews 1: 1 – 14, v14. Are they not all ministering spirits, sent forth to minister for them who shall be heirs of salvation?
7. Revelations 12: 7 – 9, v9. 9And the great dragon was cast out, that old serpent, called the Devil, and Satan, which deceived the whole world: he was cast out into the earth, and his angels were cast out with him.
8. 2 Corinthians 4: 3. But if our gospel be hid, it is hid to them that are lost: 4. In whom the god of this world hath blinded the minds of them which believe not, lest the light of the glorious gospel of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine unto them.
9. John 8: 39 – 47, v44. You are of your father the devil, and the lusts of your father you will do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and abode not in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaks a lie, he speaks of his own: for he is a liar, and the father of it.

10. John 10: 10a. The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy.

11. Matthew 24: 24. For there shall arise false Christs, and false prophets, and shall show great signs and wonders; insomuch that, if it were possible, they shall deceive the very elect.

12. Matthew 11: 1 – 11, v8. Again, the devil takes him up into an exceeding high mountain, and shows him all the kingdoms of the world, and the glory of them; 9. And says unto him, All these things will I give you, if you will fall down and worship me.

13. Matthew 28: 18. And Jesus came and spoke unto them, saying, All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth. 19. Go you therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost: 20. Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you: and, lo, I am with you always, even unto the end of the world. Amen.

13a. 1 Corinthians 15: 21. For since by man came death, by man came also the resurrection of the dead. 22. For as in Adam all die, even so in Christ shall all be made alive. 23. But every man in his own order: Christ the firstfruits; afterward they that are Christ's at his coming. 24. Then comes the end, when he shall have delivered up the kingdom to God, even the Father; when he shall have put down all rule and all authority and power. 25. For he must reign, till he hath put all enemies under his feet. 26. The last enemy that shall be destroyed is death. 27. For he hath put all things under his feet. But when he says all things are put under him, it is manifest that he is excepted, which did put all things under him. 28. And when all things shall be subdued unto him, then shall the Son also himself be subject unto him that put all things under him, that God may be all in all.

14. Romans 8: 35. Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword? 36. As it is written, For thy sake we are killed all the day long; we are accounted as sheep for the slaughter. 37. Nay, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him that loved us. 38. For I am persuaded, that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come, 39. Nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

15. Matthew 4: 10. Then said Jesus unto him, Go away Satan: for it is written, You shall worship the Lord your God, and him only shall you serve.

16. 1 John 2: 15. Love not the world, neither the things that are in the world. If any man love the world, the love of the Father is not in him. 16. For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, is not of the Father, but is of the world. 17. And the world passes away, and the lust thereof: but he that does the will of God abides for ever.

17. Genesis 3: 16: Unto the woman he said, I will greatly multiply your sorrow and your conception; in sorrow you shall bring forth children; and your desire

shall be to your husband, and he shall rule over you. 17. And unto Adam he said, Because you have listened unto the voice of your wife, and have eaten of the tree, of which I commanded you, saying, You shall not eat of it: cursed is the ground for your sake; in sorrow shall you eat of it all the days of thy life; 18. Thorns also and thistles shall it bring forth to you; and you shall eat the herb of the field; 19. In the sweat of your face shall you eat bread, till you return unto the ground; for out of it were you taken: for dusty are, and unto dust shall you return.

18. Matthew 4: 3 And when the tempter came to him, he said, If you be the Son of God, command that these stones be made bread. 1 Thessalonians 3: 1 – 13, v5. For this cause, when I could no longer forbear, I sent to know your faith, lest by some means the tempter have tempted you, and our labor be in vain.

19. Genesis 1: 27. So God created man in his own image, in the image of God created he him; male and female created he them. 28. And God blessed them, and God said unto them, Be fruitful, and multiply, and replenish the earth, and subdue it: and have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over every living thing that moves upon the earth.

20. Matthew 4: 8. Again, the devil takes him up into an exceeding high mountain, and shows him all the kingdoms of the world, and the glory of them; 9. And says unto him, All these things will I give you, if you wilt fall down and worship me.

21. Revelations 4: 10. The four and twenty elders fall down before him that sat on the throne, and worship him that lives for ever and ever, and cast their crowns before the throne, saying, 11. You art worthy, O Lord, to receive glory and honor and power: for thou hast created all things, and for your pleasure they are and were created.

22. Revelations 18. 1 – 24, 3. For all nations have drunk of the wine of the wrath of her fornication, and the kings of the earth have committed fornication with her, and the merchants of the earth are waxed rich through the abundance of her delicacies. 23. And the light of a candle shall shine no more at all in you; and the voice of the bridegroom and of the bride shall be heard no more at all in you: for your merchants were the great men of the earth; for by your sorceries were all nations deceived.

23. 2 Corinthians 4: 1 – 5, 3. But if our gospel be hid, it is hid to them that are lost: 4. In whom the god of this world hath blinded the minds of them which believe not, lest the light of the glorious gospel of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine unto them.

24. Luke 1: 1 – 2: 52, v 1: 46. And Mary said, My soul does magnify the Lord, 47. And my spirit has rejoiced in God my Savior. 48. For he has regarded the low estate of his handmaiden: for, behold, from henceforth all generations shall call me blessed.

25. Matthew 16: 13 – 17, 13. When Jesus came into the coasts of Caesarea Philippi, he asked his disciples, saying, Whom do men say that *I the Son of man* am? 14. And they said, Some say that you are John the Baptist: some, Elias; and others, Jeremias, or one of the prophets. 15. He says unto them, But whom say

you that I am? 16. And Simon Peter answered and said, you are the Christ, the Son of the living God. 17 And Jesus answered and said unto him, Blessed are you, Simon Barjona: for flesh and blood has not revealed it unto you, but my Father which is in heaven.

26. Luke 1: 35. And the angel answered and said unto her, The Holy Ghost shall come upon you, and the power of the Highest shall overshadow you: therefore also that holy thing which shall be born of you shall be called the Son of God.

27. John 8: 25 – 58, v57. Then said the Jews unto him, Thou art not yet fifty years old, and hast thou seen Abraham? 58. Jesus said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Before Abraham was, ***I am.***

28. 1 Corinthians 1: 1 – 31, v10. Now I beseech you, brethren, by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that you all speak the same thing, and that there be no divisions among you; but that you be perfectly joined together in the same mind and in the same judgment.

29. John 3: 17. For God sent not his Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through him might be saved.

30. Luke 19: 10. For the Son of man is come to seek and to save that which was lost.

31. Matthew 28: 18. And Jesus came and spoke unto them, saying, All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth. 19. Go you therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost: 20. Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you: and, lo, I am with you always, even unto the end of the world. Amen.

32. Isaiah 14: 12. How are you fallen from heaven, O Lucifer, son of the morning! how are you cut down to the ground, which didst weaken the nations! 13. For you have said in your heart, I will ascend into heaven, I will exalt my throne above the stars of God: I will sit also upon the mount of the congregation, in the sides of the north: 14. I will ascend above the heights of the clouds; I will be like the most High. 15. Yet you shall be brought down to hell, to the sides of the pit. Ezekiel 28: 12 – 16, v15. You were perfect in your ways from the day that you were created, till iniquity was found in you. 16. By the multitude of your merchandise they have filled the midst of you with violence, and you have sinned: therefore I will cast you as profane out of the mountain of God: and I will destroy you, O covering cherub, from the midst of the stones of fire.

33. Matthew 25: 41 Then shall he say also unto them on the left hand, Depart from me, ye cursed, into everlasting fire, prepared for the devil and his angels:

34. Revelations 20: 10. And the devil that deceived them was cast into the lake of fire and brimstone, where the beast and the false prophet are, and shall be tormented day and night for ever and ever. 11. And I saw a great white throne, and him that sat on it, from whose face the earth and the heaven fled away; and there was found no place for them. 12. And I saw the dead, small and great,

stand before God; and the books were opened: and another book was opened, which is the book of life: and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works. 13. And the sea gave up the dead which were in it; and death and hell delivered up the dead which were in them: and they were judged every man according to their works. 14. And death and hell were cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death. 15. And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire.

35. 2 Corinthians 11: 14. And no marvel; for Satan himself is transformed into an angel of light. 15. Therefore it is no great thing if his ministers also be transformed as the ministers of righteousness; whose end shall be according to their works.

36. 2 Peter 2: 1 – 22, v1. But there were false prophets also among the people, even as there shall be false teachers among you, who privily shall bring in damnable heresies, even denying the Lord that bought them, and bring upon themselves swift destruction. V17. These are wells without water, clouds that are carried with a tempest; to whom the mist of darkness is reserved for ever.

37. 1 Timothy 4: 1 – 16, v1. Now the Spirit speaks expressly, that in the latter times some shall depart from the faith, giving heed to seducing spirits, and doctrines of devils; 2 John v7 – 11, v9. Whosoever transgresses, and abides not in the doctrine of Christ, has not God. He that abides in the doctrine of Christ, he hath both the Father and the Son. 10. If there come any unto you, and bring not this doctrine, receive him not into your house, neither bid him God speed: 11. For he that bids him God speed is partaker of his evil deeds.

38. Daniel 12: 4. But you, O Daniel, shut up the words, and seal the book, even to the time of the end: many shall run to and fro, and knowledge shall be increased.

39. Romans 8: 28 – 39, v28. And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to his purpose. 29. For whom he did foreknow, he also did predestinate to be conformed to the image of his Son, that he might be the firstborn among many brethren. 30. Moreover whom he did predestinate, them he also called: and whom he called, them he also justified: and whom he justified, them he also glorified. 31. **What shall we then say to these things? If God be for us, who can be against us?**

40. 2 Chronicles 1 – 37, v15. And he said, Listen here, all of Judah, and you inhabitants of Jerusalem, and you king Jehoshaphat, Thus says the LORD unto you, Be not afraid nor dismayed by reason of this great multitude; for the battle is not yours, but God's.

41. Ephesians 6: 1. Children, obey your parents in the Lord: for this is right. 2. Honor your father and mother; which is the first commandment with promise; 3. That it may be well with you, and you may live long on the earth. 4. And, you fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: **but bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord.** Genesis 18: 17. And the LORD said, Shall I hide from Abraham that thing which I do; 18. Seeing that Abraham shall surely become a great and mighty nation, and all the nations of the earth shall be

blessed in him? 19. **For I know him, that he will command his children and his household after him, and they shall keep the way of the LORD, to do justice and judgment;** that the LORD may bring upon Abraham that which he hath spoken of him. Proverbs 22: 6. **Train up a child in the way he should go: and when he is old, he will not depart from it.**

42. John 14: 6. Jesus said unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man comes unto the Father, but by me. John 8: 30 – 36, v31. Then said Jesus to those Jews which believed on him, If you continue in my word, then are you my disciples indeed; 32. And you shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free.

43. Romans 6: 3 – 23, v12. Let not sin therefore reign in your mortal body, that ye should obey it in the lusts 13. Neither yield ye your members as instruments of unrighteousness unto sin: but yield yourselves unto God, as those that are alive from the dead, and your members as instruments of righteousness unto God. 18. Being then made free from sin, ye became the servants of righteousness.

44. 2 Corinthians 5: 17. Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new. 18. And all things are of God, who hath reconciled us to himself by Jesus Christ, **and hath given to us the ministry of reconciliation;** 19. To wit, that God was in Christ, reconciling the world unto himself, not imputing their trespasses unto them; **and hath committed unto us the word of reconciliation.** 20. **Now then we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God did beseech you by us: we pray you in Christ's stead, be ye reconciled to God.**

45. Hebrews 6: 1 – 20, v1. Therefore ^aleaving the principles of the doctrine of Christ, let us go on unto perfection; not laying again the foundation of repentance ^bfrom dead works, and of faith toward God, 20. Of ^cthe doctrine of baptisms, and ^dof laying on of hands, and ^eof resurrection of the dead, and ^fof eternal judgment.

47. Isaiah 14: 12 – 15, v14, I will ascend above the heights of the clouds; I will be like the most High. 2 Thessalonians 2: 1 – 12, v3. Let no man deceive you by any means: for that day shall not come, except there come a falling away first, and that man of sin be revealed, the son of perdition; 4. Who opposes and exalts himself above all that is called God, or that is worshipped; so that he as God sits in the temple of God, showing himself that he is God. 5. Do you not remember, that, when I was yet with you, I told you these things? 6. And now you know what withholds that he might be revealed in his time. 7. For the mystery of iniquity does already work: only he who now lets will let, until he be taken out of the way. 8. And then shall that Wicked be revealed, whom the Lord shall consume with the spirit of his mouth, and shall destroy with the brightness of his coming: 9. Even him, whose coming is after the working of Satan with all power and signs

and lying wonders, 10. And with all deceivableness of unrighteousness in them that perish; because they received not the love of the truth, that they might be saved. 11. And for this cause God shall send them strong delusion, that they should believe a lie: 12. That they all might be damned who believed not the truth, but had pleasure in unrighteousness.

52. Isaiah 48: 22. There is no peace, says the LORD, unto the wicked.

53. Revelations 16: 1 – 21, v16. And he gathered them together into a place called in the Hebrew tongue Armageddon. Revelations 19: 11 – 21, v19. And I saw the beast, and the kings of the earth, and their armies, gathered together to make war against him that sat on the horse, and against his army. 20. And the beast was taken, and with him the false prophet that wrought miracles before him, with which he deceived them that had received the mark of the beast, and them that worshipped his image. These both were cast alive into a lake of fire burning with brimstone.

54. 1 Thessalonians 4: 13. But I would not have you to be ignorant, brethren, concerning them which are asleep, that ye sorrow not, even as others which have no hope. 14. For if we believe that Jesus died and rose again, even so them also which sleep in Jesus will God bring with him. 15. For this we say unto you by the word of the Lord, that we which are alive and remain unto the coming of the Lord shall not prevent them which are asleep. 16. For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first: 17. Then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord. 18. Wherefore comfort one another with these words. 1 Corinthians 15: 42 – 58, 51. Behold, I show you a mystery; We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed, 52. In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump: for the trumpet shall sound, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed.

55. 1 Corinthians 3: 9. For we are laborers together with God: ye are God's husbandry, ye are God's building. 2 Corinthians 6: 1. We then, as workers together with him, beseech you also that ye receive not the grace of God in vain.

56. Genesis 49: 10. The sceptre shall not depart from Judah, nor a lawgiver from between his feet, until Shiloh come; and unto him shall the gathering of the people be. Matthew 1: 18. Now the birth of Jesus Christ was on this wise: When as his mother Mary was espoused to Joseph, before they came together, she was found with child of the Holy Ghost. 19. Then Joseph her husband, being a just man, and not willing to make her a public example, was minded to put her

away privily. 20. But while he thought on these things, behold, the angel of the LORD appeared unto him in a dream, saying, Joseph, thou son of David, fear not to take unto thee Mary thy wife: for that which is conceived in her is of the Holy Ghost. 21. And she shall bring forth a son, and you shall call his name JESUS: for he shall save his people from their sins.
